



James A. "Herk" Soteriades grew up in Whitehall. There was no school district in Whitehall at that time so students had to choose where they wanted to attend school. He graduated from Bexley High School in 1953.

Herk was one of the first paid firefighters for the Whitehall Division of Fire. He achieved the rank of Captain and served as Chief Officer of the Fire Prevention Bureau for 29 years. He retired in 1995 but continued to serve the people of Whitehall as Councilman-At-Large. He served in this position from January 1, 1997, until his death on May 7, 2000.

Herk spent many hours teaching our school children about fire prevention and safety. He and his wife, Amalee, were very supportive of the performing arts and enjoyed attending the WYHS Department of Theatre productions.

In 2005, the Whitehall Education Foundation established the James A. "Herk" Soteriades Scholarship fund to help students pursue careers in the performing arts and safety services. Two \$1,000 scholarships are awarded annually in Herk's memory to two Whitehall-Yearling High School graduating seniors.
